Arrive on the Friday afternoon set up camp and grab some dinner. Some Dads like to take some time off work on Friday and turn up early. Dads are always willing to lend a hand setting up tents. The evening often ends with a singsong around the campfire.

On Saturday a cooked breakfast is provided, followed by activities such as orienteering, games, crafts or hiking. We will have a barbecue in the evening followed by a talent show. The talent show is a highlight of the weekend with children and dads performing short dramas, magic shows, playing instruments, telling jokes and singing songs to the assembled throng. We'd like to encourage this, so if you or your kids want to prepare something, or just improvise on the night, that would be great.

On Sunday another cooked breakfast (if you still feel like it) is provided, followed by a small get together. The rest of the day will consist of lunch, games and time just 'to be' and 'to do' whatever you want with your family. Just before we leave we will have a fun team challenge activity and then leave at about 4pm.
